

Knit Baby Hat Project

Anne Arundel Medical Center Auxiliary
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**Please use WHITE or
VARIEGATED, pastel colors,
solid pink, blue, yellow, green, etc.
No tassels**

Use acrylic four-ply yarn or fine baby yarn doubled. Wintuk four-ply makes a nice soft cap. Use #10 needles or, if you knit loosely, use #8 needles.

Gauge should be approximately 4.5 stitches per inch and six rows per inch.

- Cast on 44 stitches if using #10 needles (48 stitches if using #8 needles).
- Knit 2, purl 2 for 36 rows or until works is 7 inches long.
- On next row, knit 2 together then purl 2 together to end of row.
- On next row, knit 2 together to end of row (12 stitches remaining).
- Do not cast off, but thread needle and draw through stitches. Pull them up tight and fasten off.
- Sew seam from bottom up to top. This prevents hat from unraveling and coming apart.

Caps, before sewing up the seam, should measure approximately 6 to 6.5 inches wide by 7.5 inches long.
